

Signs You Need An Evaluation

- Takes forever to feed or only takes tiny amounts
- Clicking, leaking milk, or losing latch
- Crying, arching, coughing, gagging, or choking
- Gassy, refluxy, or uncomfortable after eating
- Falling asleep before finishing
- Slow weight gain or very frequent feeds
- Only feeds well when drowsy or at night

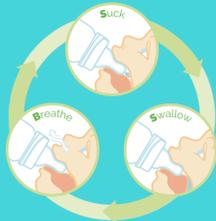

Why Babies Struggle With Feeding

Oral-Motor Challenges

Your baby may struggle to coordinate suck-swallow-breathe. You may notice:

- Clicking
- Swallowing air
- Fatigue
- Poor milk transfer
- Gagging/coughing



Structural Differences

Tongue/lip tie, high palate, or jaw tension can make latching hard or painful.



Sensory Overwhelm

Some babies shut down during feeds when they feel overstimulated.



GI Discomfort

Reflux, gas, or constipation can make feeding feel painful.
